

## **Full User Guide**

(We suggest this full process for the first use of ThurayaLocate, particularly if you have not used the GPS features of your handset before. After first use, follow the quick guide below)

- Switch on the Hughes/Ascom Handset (via the separate red power button on Hughes and via the red power/call end button on Ascom) and store the number +278388918342 in your phonebook (under ThurayaLocate or similar)
- With the handset upright, in an out-of-doors location and with a clear view of the sky overhead, select the menu option (by pressing the right hand soft key)
- Scroll down 7 places to GPS Manager using the c key, press Select via the left hand soft key, and select 'Current Position'
- The handset will then display 'Acquiring' meaning that the handset is looking for GPS satellites - this may take an extended time on Ascom handsets (up to 30 minutes or more) if the handset has not recently been used in SAT mode. Once a position is found the screen will display your current location
- Select 'Options' via the left hand soft key, scroll down using the c key to 'Send as SMS' and select,
- Then select 'Names' via the left hand soft key which will take you into your phonebook
- Select the ThurayaLocate number you stored in step 1, and press Send
- The GPS co-ordinates will now be sent. You will see confirmation of the process on the screen

## **Quick Guide**

- Take handset outside, hold or stand upright, acquire GPS Current position by pressing 8,1
- Press 'Send as SMS' and select ThurayaLocate number from phone book, press Send
